Achieving financial targets to support these goals, such as securing funding in the range of \$250,000 to \$1 million for property acquisition and development, is also a key short-term objective.

By adopting a nature-based and holistic educational approach, Lavender Hill offers a unique alternative to traditional childcare options, meeting the specific needs of Longmont families. Future alignment with state initiatives like UPK and CCAP will enable Lavender Hill to expand its support and collaboration, enhancing its capacity to serve the community effectively and contribute to the broader goal of accessible, quality early education in Colorado.

Total Addressable Market (TAM)

Estimating the Total Addressable Market (TAM) for Lavender Hill Preschool in Boulder County, with 6,000 children under 5, targets a 1-5% market share, equating to 60-300 children. Assuming \$10,000 annual tuition per child, the monetary TAM value ranges from \$600,000 to \$3,000,000. This projection serves as a financial benchmark for potential revenue within the early childhood education market, highlighting the preschool's growth opportunities.

Serviceable Available Market (SAM)

Calculating the Serviceable Available Market (SAM) value for Lavender Hill Preschool, with estimates reflecting a range of 30 to 50 children at the low end and 40 to 75 children at the high end, and based on an annual tuition of \$10,000 per child:

- **At the low end (30-50 children)**, the SAM value ranges:
 - From 30 children x \$10,000 = \$300,000

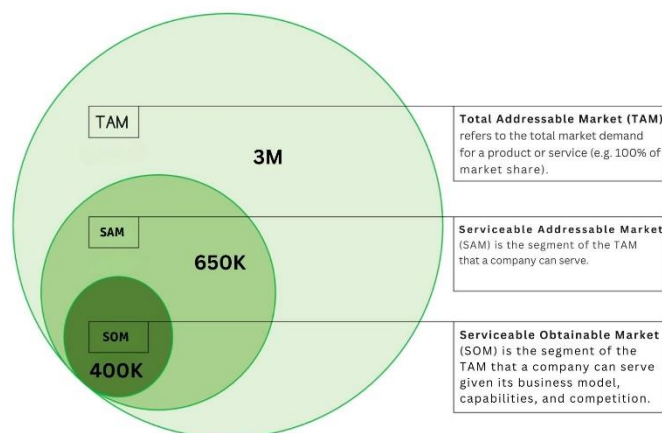


- To 50 children x \$10,000 = \$500,000
- **At the high end (40-75 children)**, the SAM value extends:
 - From 40 children x \$10,000 = \$400,000
 - To 75 children x \$10,000 = \$750,000

This reflects the potential annual revenue from Lavender Hill Preschool's target market within Boulder County, focusing on those interested in a Waldorf-inspired, nature-based educational offering.

Serviceable Obtainable Market (SOM)

To estimate the Serviceable Obtainable Market (SOM) for Lavender Hill Preschool, which is the portion of the SAM realistically expected to be captured, we consider a more conservative approach. Assuming Lavender Hill can capture 50-60% of its SAM in the initial years post-expansion, with the Serviceable Available Market (SAM) estimates of \$300,000 to \$500,000 at the low end and \$400,000 to \$750,000 at the high end:



- **For the SAM range of \$300,000 to \$500,000:**
 - Capturing 50% would yield an SOM of \$150,000 to \$250,000.
 - Capturing 60% would yield an SOM of \$180,000 to \$300,000.
- **For the SAM range of \$400,000 to \$750,000:**
 - Capturing 50% would result in an SOM of \$200,000 to \$375,000.
 - Capturing 60% would result in an SOM of \$240,000 to \$450,000.

This SOM range reflects realistic first-year revenue targets post-expansion, considering competition and market penetration rates.



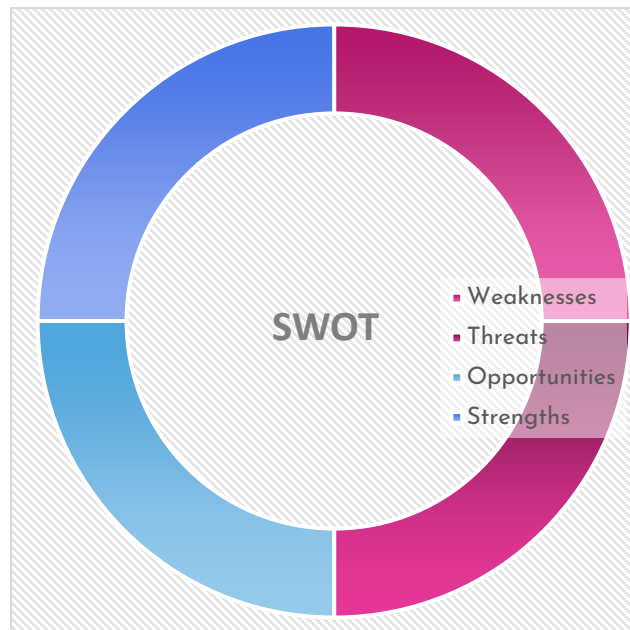

attributed to the rising disposable income in emerging economies and the efforts by governments and NGOs to combat illiteracy, especially in underdeveloped and developing countries.
